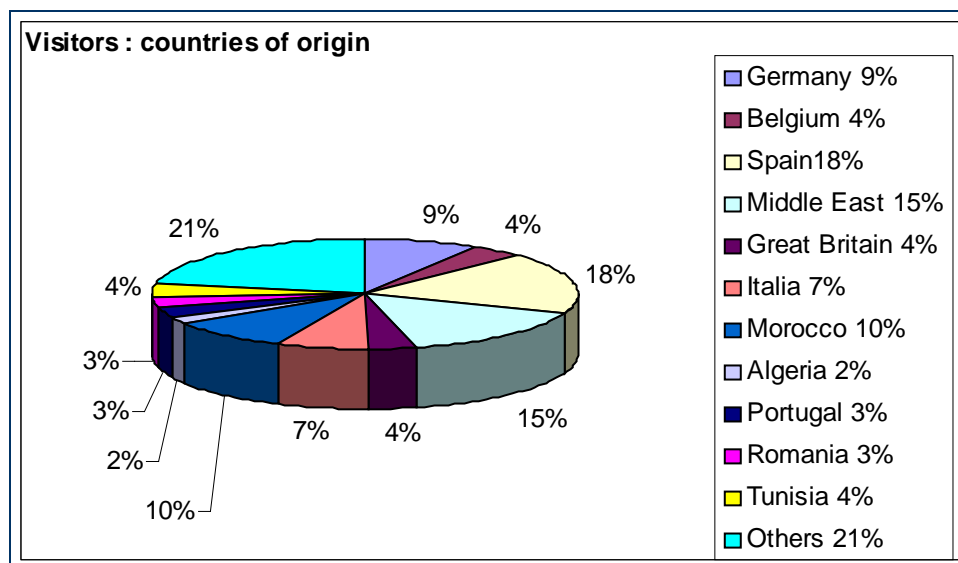
➤ ENERGAÏA 2007: figures

During the 3 days of the event, ENERGAIA 2007 received 19 000 visitors: 9 560 professionals from 63 countries, including the buyers invited by the Business Forum (FIA) ENERGAÏA, as well as 9 000 public visitors on the days dedicated to them. Several european regions were represented.

Solar energy, wind energy, wood energy, investments... the different components of renewable energies were represented with a section dedicated to green building. The show in total welcomed 203 exhibitors from 13 countries (France, Spain, Germany, Morocco, Italy, Lebanon...).

The international conferences gathered over 1 200 professionals, and the B to B Forum (FIA) organised by Septimanie Export, 310 different International business meetings.

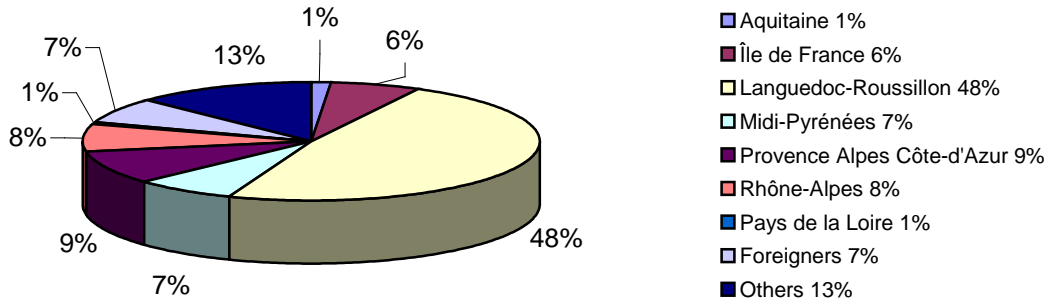

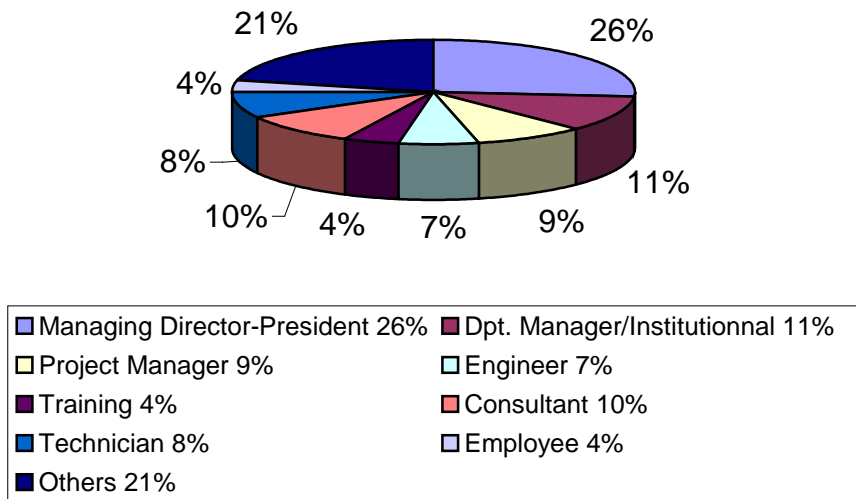

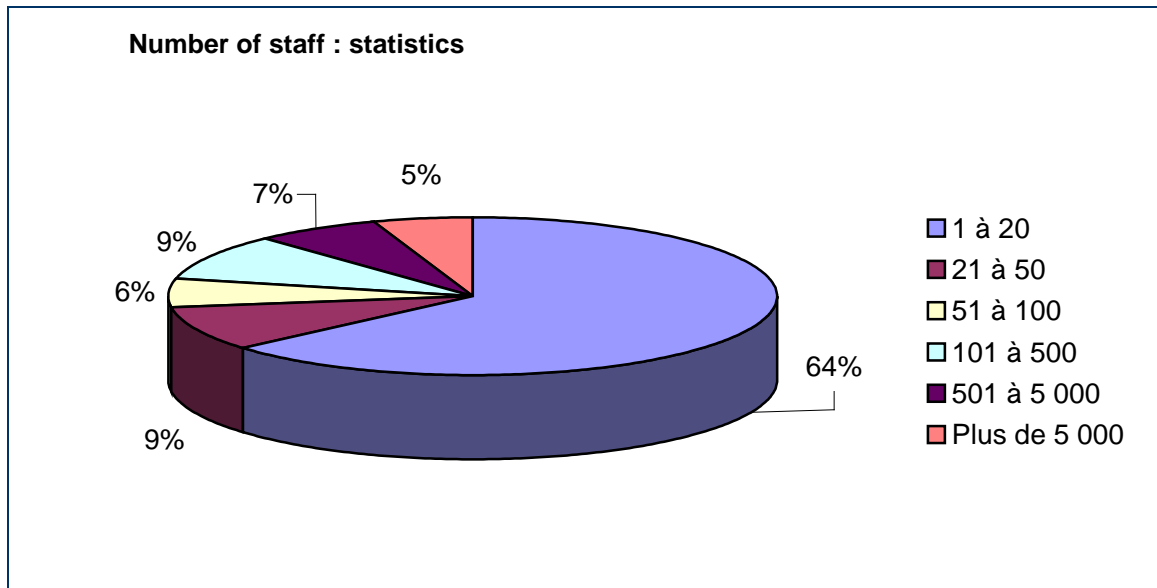

Visitors: economic regions of origin

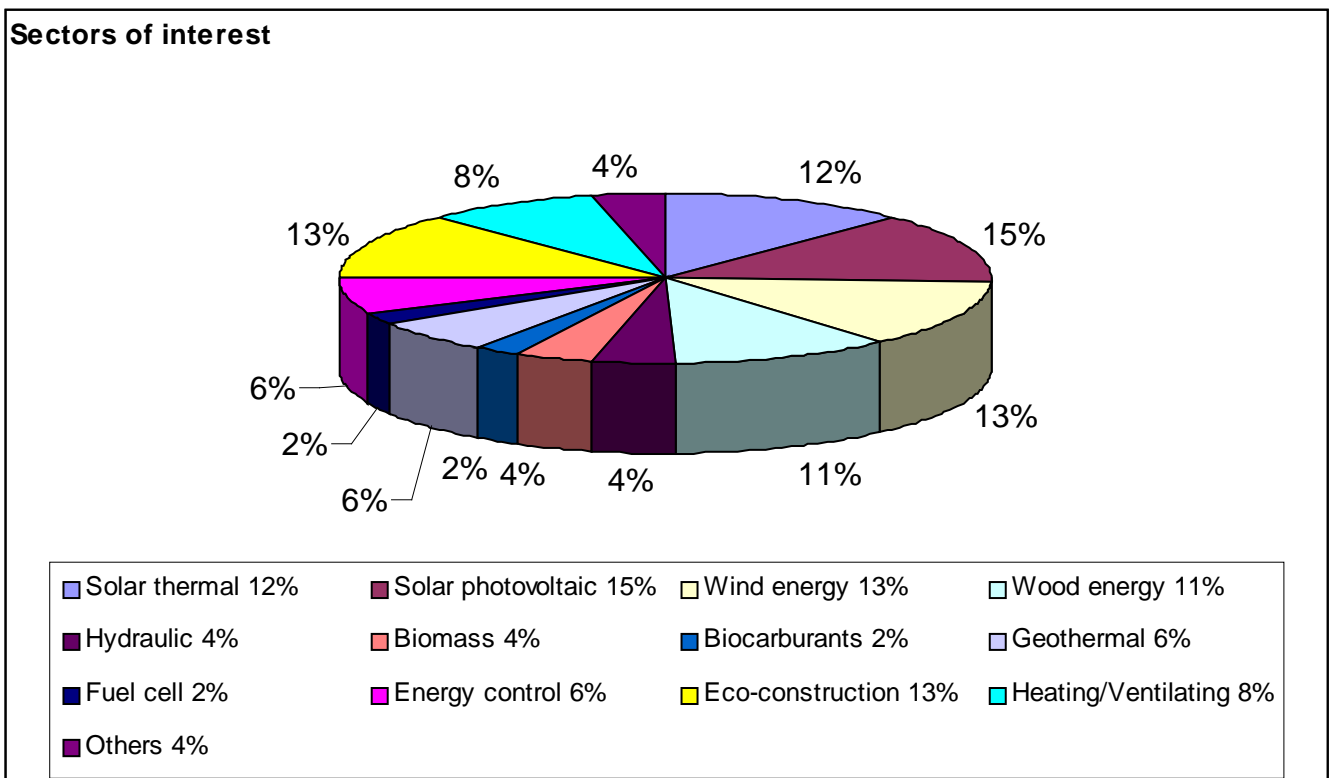

ENERGAÏA International Conferences were considered as a tremendous success. This is mainly due to the deep involvement of the international scientific committee headed by Stephane Pouffary, Head of the International Expertise in Energy Management Unit of ADEME (the French National Environment and Energy Management Agency).

The very high level program gathered over 120 international speakers and was attended by over 1200 International delegates.



Furthermore, the presentation given by exhibitors on the two Agora open platforms gathered each between 80 and 160 attendees.

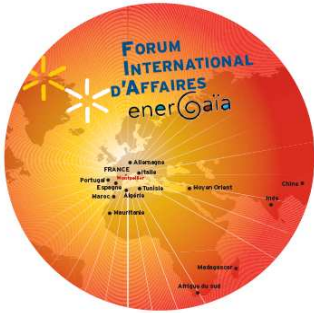

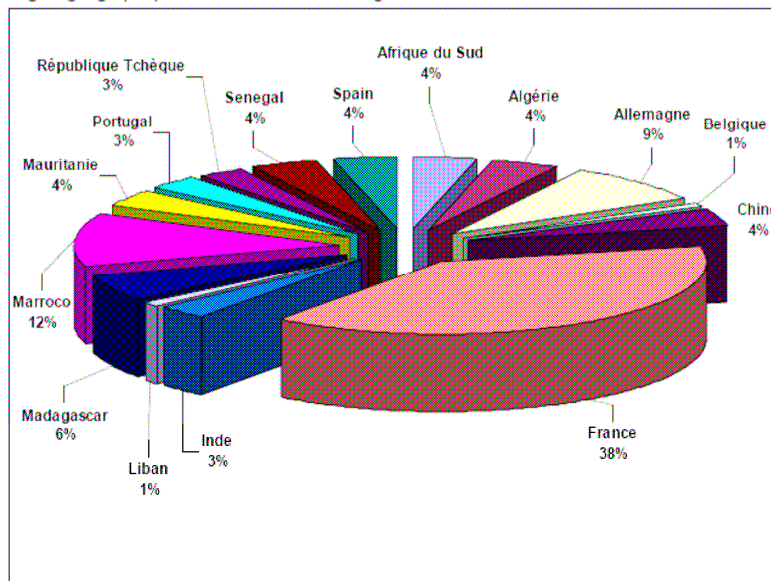
